## It's the Law!

This is an issue that has been address several times over the years and it still remains a concern! **Memphis has a leash law and a law requiring owners to pick up after their pets. It is a crime to leave dog waste behind.**

\*\*Memphis Code, Chapter 8-16, Sections 6 through 9; Shelby County Code, Chapter3, Section 3-40, Paragraph (D) and Section 3-41; Tennessee Code, Section 44-8-408.

With spring and summer approaching more and more adults and children will be out taking advantage of the beautiful weather. If you let your dog run loose you could be responsible for bringing harm to a fellow neighbor, motorist, other dog or your own. Dog waste that is not picked up will eventually be washed into the street, down the gutter and into the storm drain which leads to our waterways. The bacteria from your pet's waste can contaminate our water supply. Also, it isn't pleasant or sanitary to step in.
