Ridgeway Police Station News

The Memphis Police Department's **Citizens Police Academy (CPA)** begins Tuesday, September 8th at Ridgeway Police Station. It is a nine week program that meets once a week from 6:00PM to 8:00PM.

The CPA offers citizens insight into the different areas of police service and an opportunity to meet and communicate with officers.

The curriculum includes such topics as Robbery, Vehicle Theft, Gang Unit, Domestic Violence, Canine Unit, Sex Crimes, Economic Crime and much more.

There is no cost to attend the Citizen's Police Academy and applicants must be 18 years old.
