MLG&W News

Your Memphis owned Electric Gas and Water Utility has been in the news lately as they seek to both improve service to the community as well as reduce costs. MLGW purchases power (gas & electric) from outside suppliers and pumps our water from the local Memphis Aquifer. Our distribution system is aging and needs significant improvement.

To help in that effort, the Memphis City Council recently approved a water, gas and electric rate increase, but the utility still needs to work to improve operations and lower costs by leveraging technology to reduce labor costs; improve restoral time and reduce the quantity of outages.

The cost of purchased power has become a concern and in response the Leadership of MLGW, in cooperation with many Neighborhood groups and concerned citizens, has been working on an *Integrated Resource Plan (IRP)*. The first public draft of this plan will be presented to the citizens of Shelby county on **March 25th at the Benjamin Hooks Public Library**. The meeting will begin at **6:00pm**. The final plan, to be approved by the City Council in May, will affect our Gas and Electric Utility services for the next 20 years.

KSANA is encouraging all our Neighbors to come out and participate in the discussion. Your input is very much appreciated and encouraged by the City.

Ridgeway Station News

Spring Reminder!

- Keep your yard maintained! "It is a violation to allow grass or weeds to grow over 12 inches high, or allow plants, shrubs and trees to grow in a manner that will obstruct pedestrian traffic or visibility of motorists".
- Be responsible for your pet! It is a violation to let your dogs run loose. Please keep them on a leash. "Next time you walk your dog, please bring a plastic bag to pick up your dog's waste and throw it in the trash. It's illegal to leave it behind".
- Take care of your swimming pool! Pools that have stagnant water are breeding grounds for mosquitoes and other undesirable elements that are health hazards. This year the weather conditions have been favorable for mosquitoes which can carry various viruses. Even pets can be infected by mosquito bites.
