Security, Security, Security

The SkyCop project continues to trudge along. On 07/27, we had \$17,000 in donations and pledges from 68 households. Clearly, that is not enough. We need at least that many more households participating to reach our goal of \$36,000.

Effective July 1, KSANA canceled our Security One patrol service. At \$5,000 per year for a daily drive-through, it no longer seemed like a prudent solution. Not when, if enough people make a one-time, tax-deductible \$250 donation, we can have recorded surveillance of the entrances to the neighborhood 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and a very visible camera system to warn off any criminal-types.

What are WE doing?

We have communicated the value of this project via email, newsletters, direct mailings, and meetings. We have sent letters to 22 landlords asking for donations. We have also applied for a small grant. Our next step is to go door-to-door to reach out to those for whom we have no email or phone number. We're not trying to be pests, but we do want to make sure we've connected with everyone in the neighborhood who wants to contribute to such a worthwhile project.

What can YOU do to help?

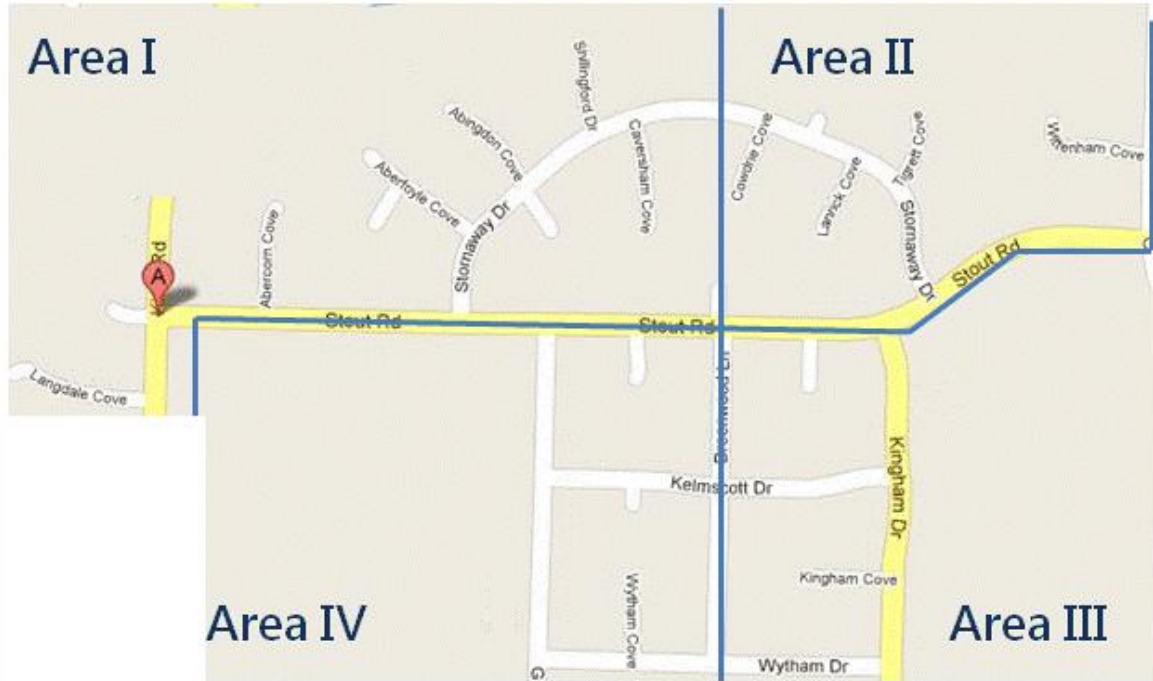
One of our greatest frustrations right now is that we keep hearing of and from people who intend to donate "when we have enough donations." While we *think* we understand the intention behind that rationale, we also know that we can't know when we have enough donations until people either donate or **tell us** they intend to be part of the project. Please let us know of your intentions and let your neighbors know that we need to hear from them--soon! (Remind them that it's tax deductible!)

We can also use volunteers to help in our door-to-door campaign. No hard-sell stuff, just sharing information.
