Southeast Memphis Neighborhood Partnership

Lynda Whalen, President of BANA, chairs the SE Partnership program which deals with code violations. The SE Partnership is a coalition of multiple neighborhood associations, tasked with keeping Neighborhoods Safe and Clean. The group has monthly joint meetings with the Memphis Police Department, Shelby County Sheriff Department, Shelby County Health Department, County Codes, City Codes, Animal Control, Solid Waste, Memphis City Beautiful and Clean Memphis. Each agency is responsible for different code violations. Examples of complaints:

- Parking in the yard/on grass, overgrown yards, inoperable vehicles, more than four cars parked in driveway. MPD
- Cars in grass, warrants anywhere in county. Shelby County Sheriff Dept
- Peeling paint, trash carports, tarps. City Codes
- Building structures, illegal business. County Codes
- Abandoned pools, pools in disrepair, water leaks, vermin infestation. Health Department
- Welfare of dogs, dogs running loose, abandoned dogs. Animal Control
- Debris, trash always at curb, tires in yard, debris and limbs blocking sidewalk. Solid Waste. City of Memphis.
