Trash & Recycling Bins

According to City ordinances trash and recycling bins are to be put out on the curb the day of pick up and are to be removed by 7:00pm. Sometimes there is a need to put them out late the night before and that would be ok, but not days before pick up.

Also, help keep the storm drains free of debris by bagging your leaves and grass clippings if you are not leaving them on your lawn. This helps reduce the risk of street flooding. Thank you!
