Keswick Stornaway Neighborhood Voting Information

Keswick-Stornaway is divided into two voting precincts. Neighbors on the south side of Stout are in Precinct 08107-I; the north side of Stout is in Precinct 08103-S2. The only difference in representation or districts is that the south of Stout residents are in U.S. Congressional District 9, while everyone north of Stout is in U.S. Congressional District 8.

Precinct 08107-I votes at Balmoral Presbyterian Church (6413 Quince), and Precinct 08103-S2 votes at Ridgeway Middle School (6333 Quince). Don't worry if you get it confused as these two polling places are approximately 200 yards apart.
